


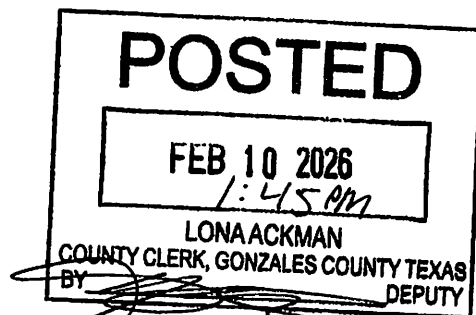
**Notice of Regular Meeting
