

**Called Meeting of the Gonzales Central Appraisal District Appraisal Review Board**

1. Declaration of quorum and call to order.
2. Oaths of Office.
3. Selection of Vice-Chairman.
4. Consideration of and possible action to amend the Appraisal Review Board Hearing Procedures.
5. Consideration of and possible action to adopt Resolution No. 422, approving the Appraisal Review Board Hearing Procedures for 2026.
6. Submission of corrections to the appraisal roll in compliance with Section 25.25 (b), Texas Property Tax Code.
7. Consideration of and possible action on corrections to the appraisal roll pursuant to Section 25.25, Texas Property Tax Code. (A list of appellants is on file at the appraisal district office).
8. Consider whether good cause exists for late protests pursuant to Texas Property Tax Code, Section 41.44(b) and hearing of late-filed protests if board grants relief. (A list of appellants is on file at the appraisal district office).
9. Consideration of and possible action on supplementing omitted property pursuant to Section 25.23, Texas Property Tax Code.
10. Adjournment.

If, during the course of the meeting, discussion of any item on the agenda should be held in a closed meeting, the Board will conduct a closed meeting in accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act, Government Code, Chapter 551, Subchapters D & E. Before any closed meeting is convened, the presiding officer will publicly identify the Section of Sections of the Act authorizing the closed meeting. All final votes, actions, or decisions will be taken in open meeting.
